	2. CAPITATION FEES 2023-24:		
	Affiliation fees to be paid to Bowls Tasmania for 2023-24 is \$70 526. Bowls Tasmania has increase		
	affiliation fees by 2.5% in line with CPI index. Current affiliation fees are \$90 (\$57 Bowls Tasmania		
	fee & \$33 Bowls North fee). Bowls North fee has not changed for 3 years. Bowls North income did not cover Bowls Tasmania fee in 2022-23, with a shortfall of over \$4 000. Bowls North membership		
	and therefore our income is likely to fall with our expense continuing to increase. There are two		
	options for affiliation fee structure for 2023-24. Fixed fee model or as previous season per head		
	capitation. Fixed fee model would be detrimental for smaller clubs and has advantages for larger		
	clubs. In 2022-23 the BN finance committee recommended that Bowls North move to a per team		
	capitation structure. The 2.5% increase in Bowls Tasmania fees was not taken into consideration		
	when setting the proposed fee model for 2023-24. Discussion held.
